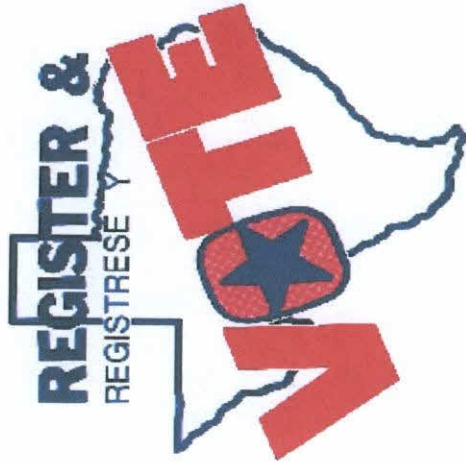

PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION LISTED TO ASSIST YOU IN THE VOTING PROCESS IN TRAVIS COUNTY.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

Your Voter Certificate will provide the following information:

- Your Travis County certificate number.
- Your Precinct number.
- The effective dates of the certificate.
- Your Congressional, Senatorial, Legislative, Commissioner, Justice of the Peace, School District, Single Member District (if any) and City jurisdictions.
- Your physical address which determines your precinct information.
- Your mailing address where all correspondence will be sent.

Certificates are automatically renewed and mailed by December 6 of each odd-numbered year.

YOU WILL RECEIVE A VOTER REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE IN THE MAIL WITHIN 30 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF A COMPLETED VOTER APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE

To be eligible to vote in an election in Travis County, you must be:

1. A qualified voter on the day that you vote.
2. A resident of the territory covered by the election.
3. Satisfy all other requirement for voting prescribed by law for the particular election.

WHEN VOTING

- You are eligible to cast a ballot in the precinct and political jurisdictions listed on your voter registration certificate.
- You must present your voter registration certificate or picture ID when voting.

POLLING PLACE INFORMATION

Travis County has three voting programs:

1. Early Voting in Person, (14 day period prior to the election),
2. Election Day voting, and
3. Early Voting By Mail (special criteria must be met).

- Voting locations are published in the newspaper on Election Day and are listed by precinct number. Early Voting in Person

locations are published each day during the 14 day Early Voting Period. Polling place information is also available on our website:

- Remember you must present your Voter Registration Certificate or picture ID when voting.

CHANGE OF NAME OR ADDRESS

Promptly notify the Voter Registrar in writing of your new name or address by:

1. Correcting the information on your current voter registration certificate and returning it to the Voter Registrar with your signature.
2. Completing a voter registration application and marking the change box.
3. If you do not have your current certificate or unable to obtain an application, you may submit changes in writing and include your name, date of birth and your signature.

MOVING TO ANOTHER COUNTY

You must re-register; complete an application and mail it or take it in person to the voter registrar of your new county.
